Once again, we welcome you to the 14th Annual Subsistence Memorial Gathering.

The first annual gathering of Tribes from the Chugach Region began in 1999, ten years after the Exxon Valdez Oil Spill. We were facing many diverse challenges as a result of the oil spill. It has been 25 years since March 24, 2989, and the challenges have changed, but the Chugach people continue to work together to thrive in this changing world of ours.

In the past, the Gathering focused on natural resource and environmental issues of concern to the Chugach Tribes. This event normally consists of panel presentations, individual program reports, guest speakers from state and federal management agencies, and roundtable discussions on various natural resource related issues. This event provides a valuable forum to share information and to receive feedback from the villages on what they feel is important to them, including any natural resource issues of concern that CRRC should be addressing.

Today, we will present information on two Chugach Region initiatives: t1) he Chugach Region Economic Development Initiative led by Chugach Alaska Corporation, and t2 the CRRC Climate Change Adaptation Planning Project.

Now, more than ever, we must join together to face the challenges ahead, like climate change, funding cutbacks, and threats to our subsistence way of life.

Most importantly, let us take a moment to remember where we came from, why we live the lifestyle we do, and take the time to enjoy each other as Native people. Thank you for coming and sharing this wonderful day with us!
