SALVAGE OF MEAT



Prohibited actions:

- Hand holding antler
- Antler on food
- Electronic device
- KEEP IT (antler on ground)
- PROOF OF SEX MUST REMAIN NATURALLY ATTACHED TO MEAT
- ANTLERS ARE NOT PROOF OF SEX

Arrow Hunt Rules:

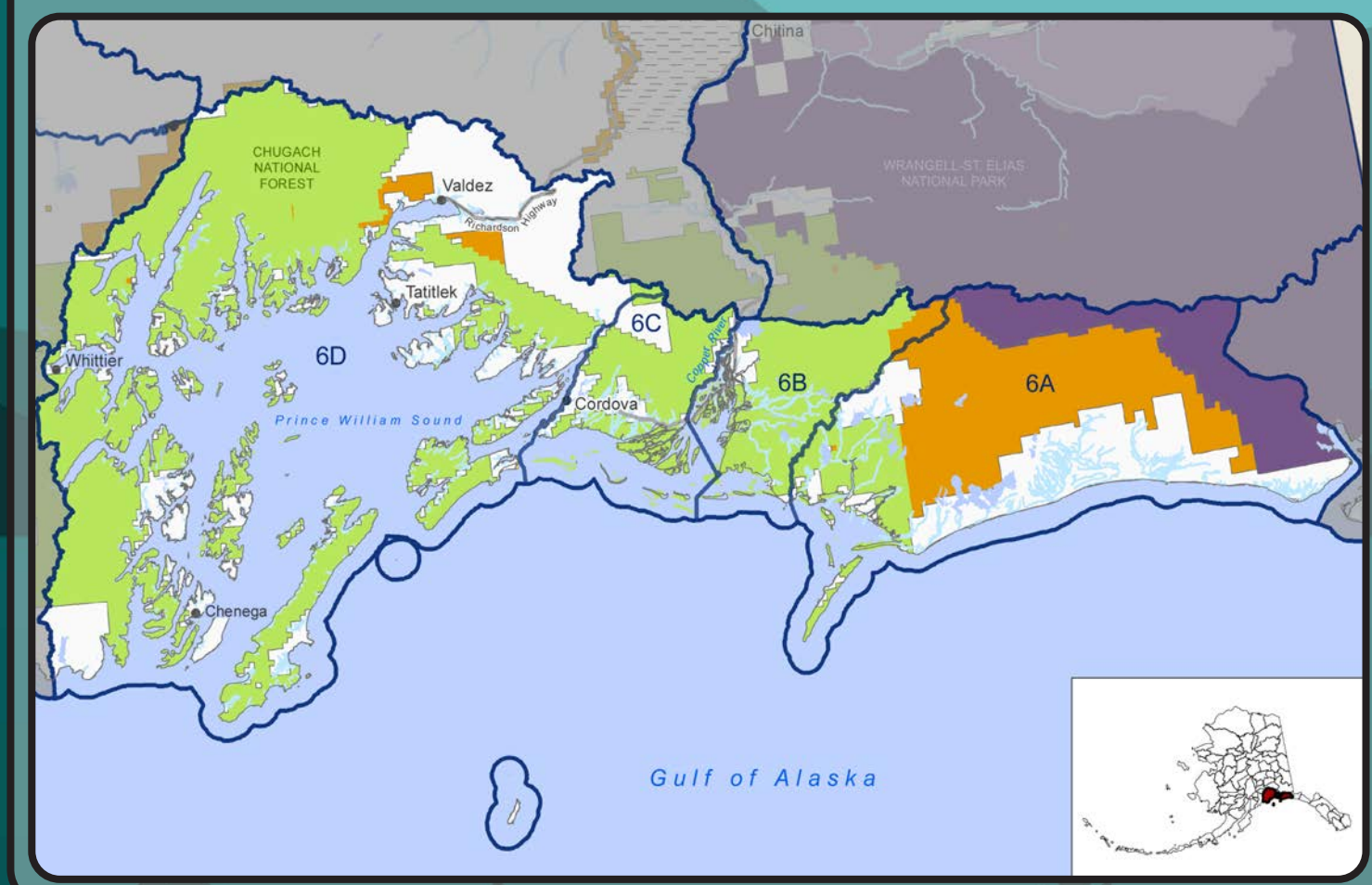
- Prohibited arrow
- Allowed arrows
- +20 in, +300 (arrow length)
- DRAW WEIGHT 50 lbs

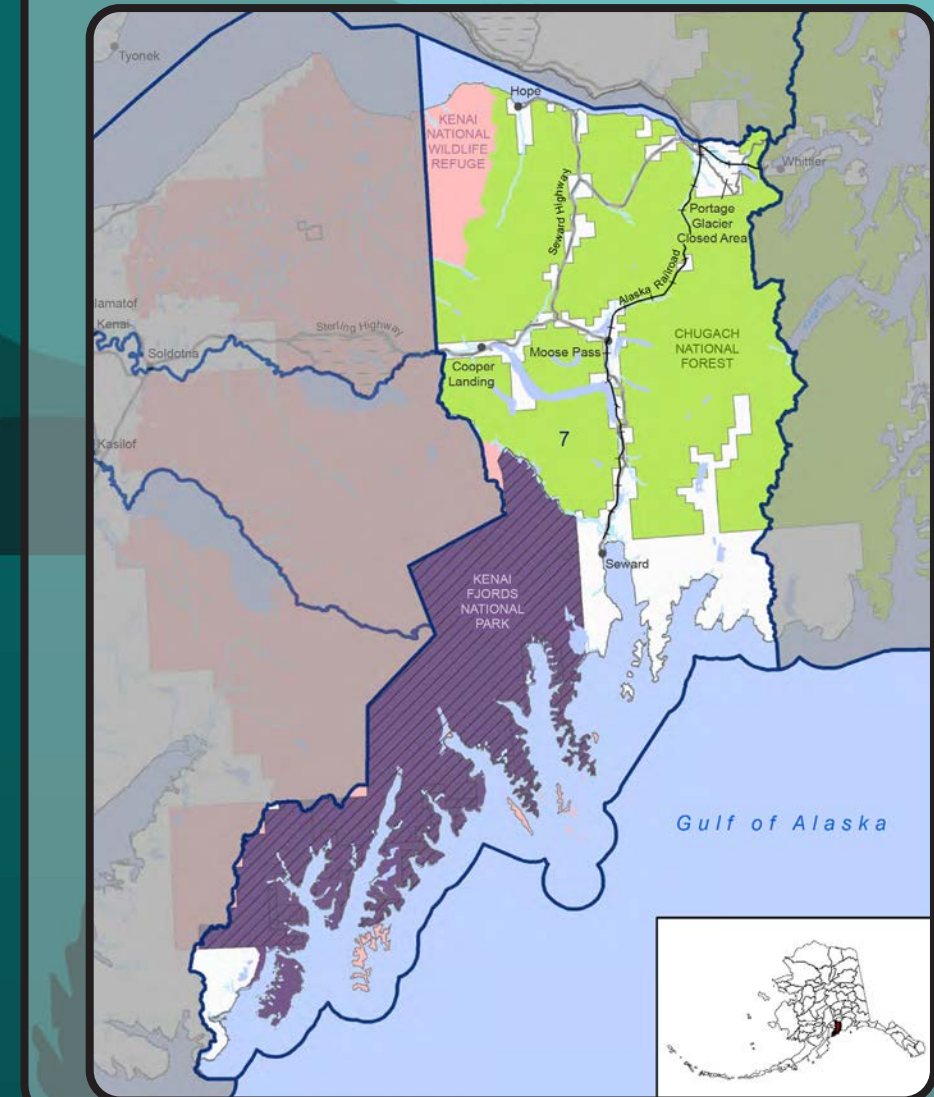

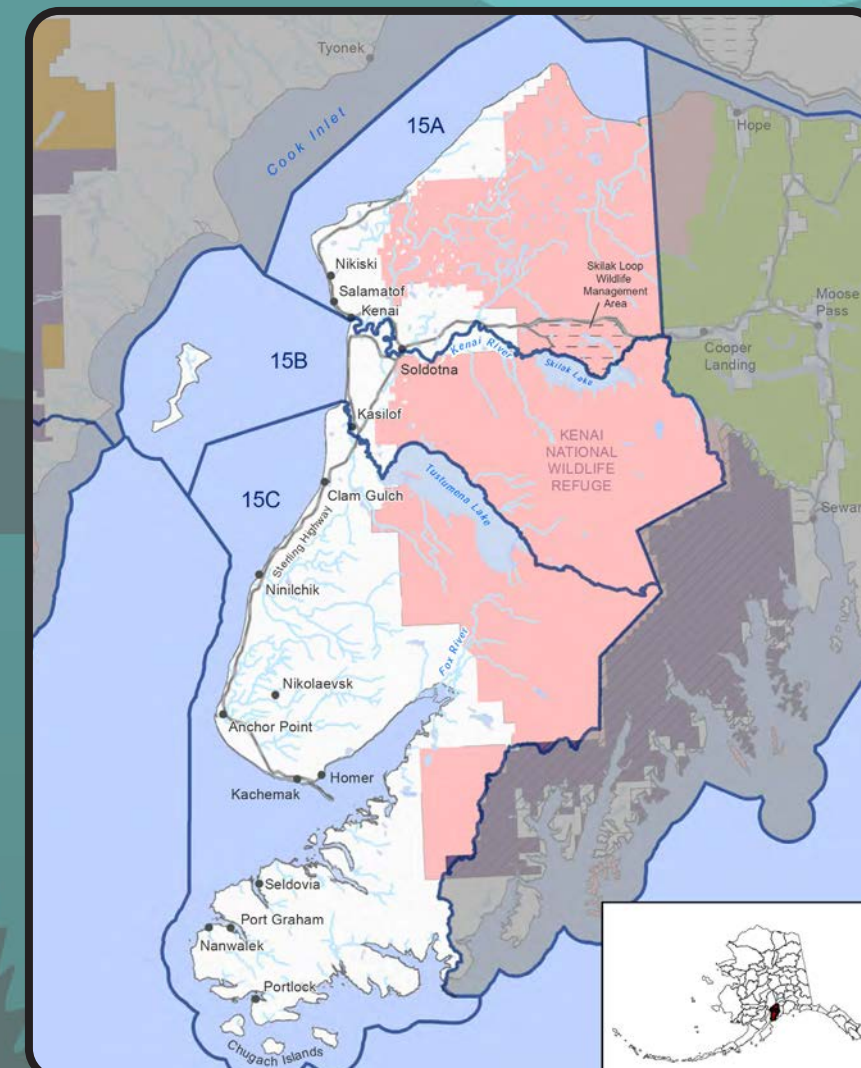
