6	All Rural Residents	FIVE DEER TOTAL OCT. 1 to DEC. 31	AUG. 1 to JAN. 31	<p>Up to 5 permits will be issued by the Cordova District Ranger to the Native Village of Chenega annually to harvest from Federal public lands in Unit 6D for their annual Old Chenega Memorial and other traditional memorial potlatch ceremonies. Permits will have effective dates of July 1 - June 30. (FD0606)</p> <p>* Up to 5 permits will be issued by the Cordova District Ranger to the Tatitlek IRA Council annually to harvest from Federal public lands in Unit 6D for their annual Cultural Heritage Week. Permits will have effective dates of July 1 - June 30. (FD0606)</p>

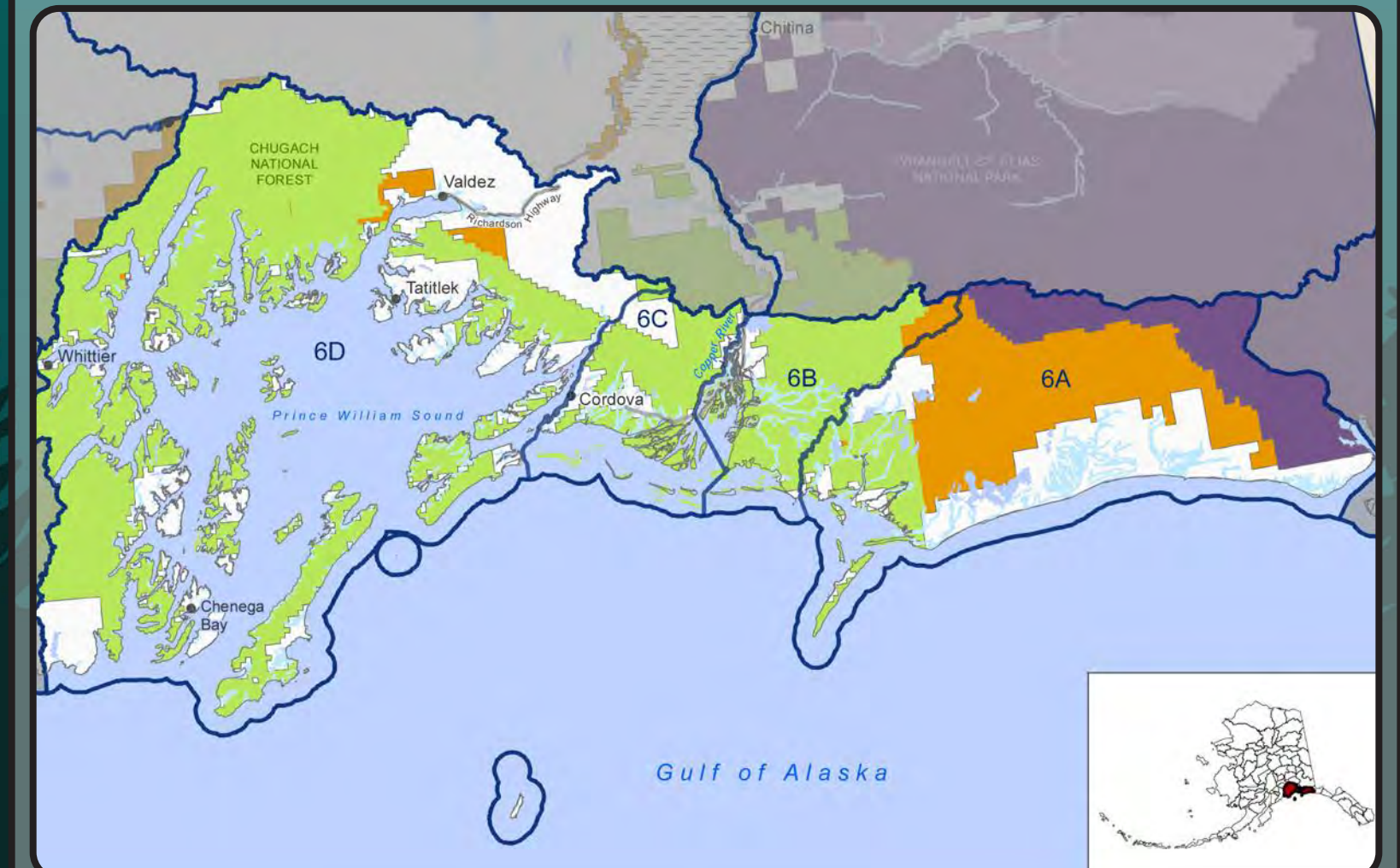
