To fish legally, you'll need a Prince William Sound Subsistence Dungeness Crab Permit — **it's FREE and available online to Alaska Residents Only.**

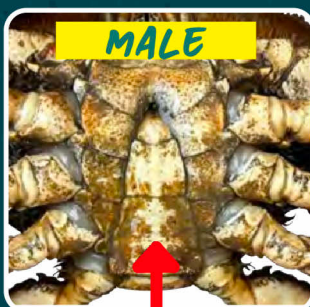

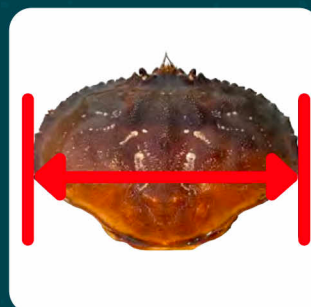
⚠️ REGULATIONS REMINDER



A wide uneven abdominal flap covers most of the underside



A narrow triangular abdominal flap covers the underside



The width of a Dungeness crab is measured as the straight-line distance across the carapace, excluding the spines

- ✓ Harvesting female Dungeness crab is not allowed. **Use the guide above to identify crab sex. Males have a narrow, triangular abdominal flap.**
- ✓ You must measure the width across the top of the shell excluding the spines to ensure it's legal size (greater than 6 1/2 inches).
- ✓ You are only allowed to fish in designated Prince William Sound subsistence areas — check the permit map for approved zones.
- ✓ Permit holders are required to report harvest online by January 15, 2026, even if no crab were caught. Failure to report = ineligibility next season.
