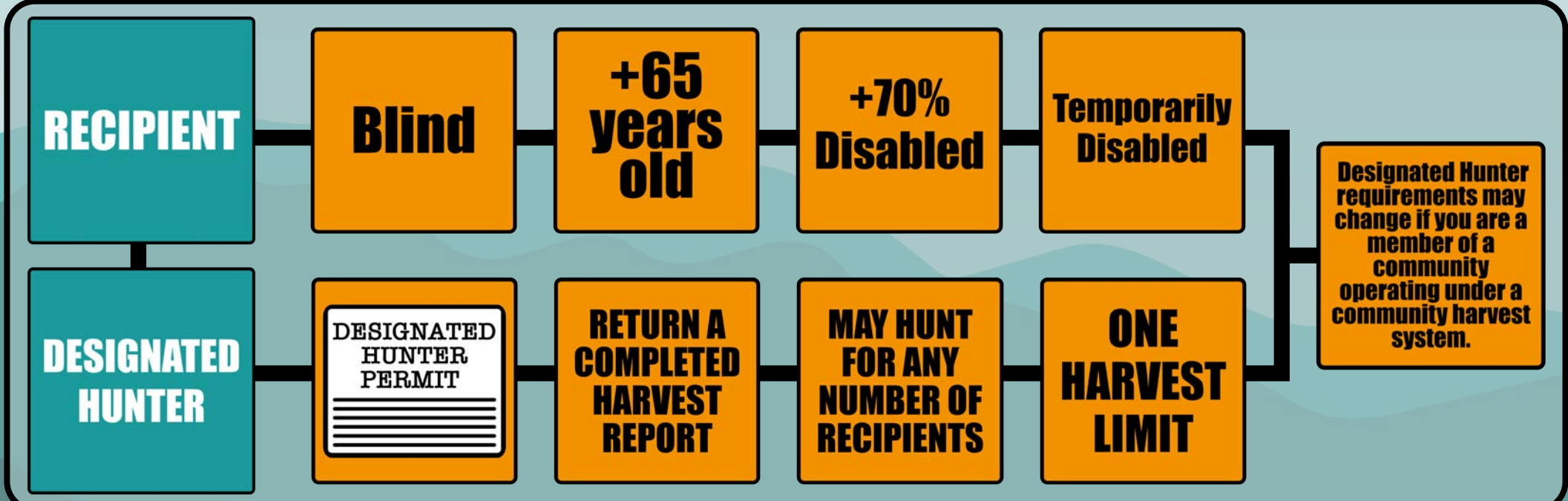

Permits will have effective dates of July 1 - June 30.
