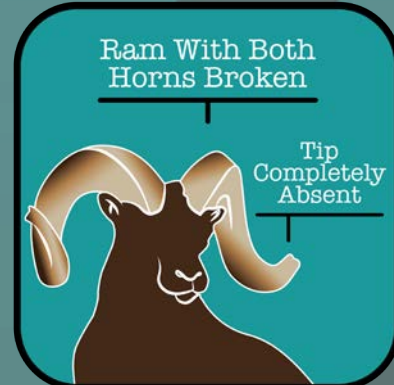
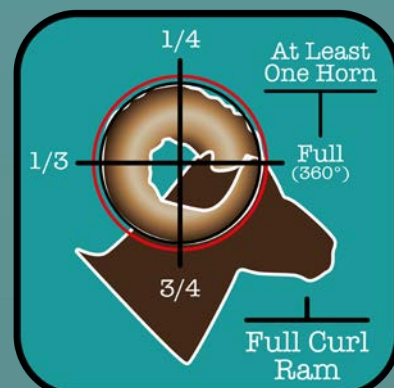


KENAI MOOSE RESEARCH CENTER CLOSED AREA - THAT AREA WITHIN THE OUTER BOUNDARY FENCES OF THE KENAI MOOSE RESEARCH CENTER, LOCATED WEST AND SOUTH OF COYOTE AND VIXEN LAKES IS CLOSED TO ALL HUNTING. **RUSSIAN RIVER CLOSED AREA** - THAT AREA WITHIN 150 YARDS, AND INCLUDING THE RIVER, FROM THE OUTLET OF LOWER RUSSIAN LAKE DOWNSTREAM TO THE RUSSIAN RIVER/ KENAI RIVER CONFLUENCE, THEN CONTINUING DOWNSTREAM 700 YARDS ALONG THE BANK OF THE KENAI RIVER, IS CLOSED TO HUNTING FOR THE MONTHS OF JUNE AND JULY.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS

THE SKILAK LOOP WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA IS CLOSED TO SUBSISTENCE TAKING OF WILDLIFE, EXCEPT THAT GROUSE, PTARMIGAN, AND HARE MAY BE TAKEN ONLY FROM OCTOBER 1 - MARCH 1, BY BOW AND ARROW ONLY. THIS AREA CONSISTS OF THAT PORTION OF UNIT 15A BOUNDED BY A LINE BEGINNING AT THE EASTERNMOST JUNCTION OF THE STERLING HIGHWAY AND THE SKILAK LOOP (MILEPOST 76.3); THEN DUE SOUTH TO THE SOUTH BANK OF THE KENAI RIVER; THEN SOUTHERLY ALONG THE SOUTH BANK OF THE KENAI RIVER TO ITS CONFLUENCE WITH SKILAK LAKE; THEN WESTERLY ALONG THE NORTH SHORE OF SKILAK LAKE TO LOWER SKILAK LAKE CAMPGROUND; THEN NORTHERLY ALONG THE LOWER SKILAK LAKE CAMPGROUND ROAD AND THE SKILAK LOOP ROAD TO ITS WESTERNMOST JUNCTION WITH THE STERLING HIGHWAY; AND THEN EASTERLY ALONG THE STERLING HIGHWAY TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
