ANYONE BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1986 OR IS 18 YEARS OLD OR OLDER MUST HAVE PASSED AN ADF&G HUNTER EDUCATION COURSE TO HUNT BIG GAME IN ALASKA (UNITS 7 AND 15).

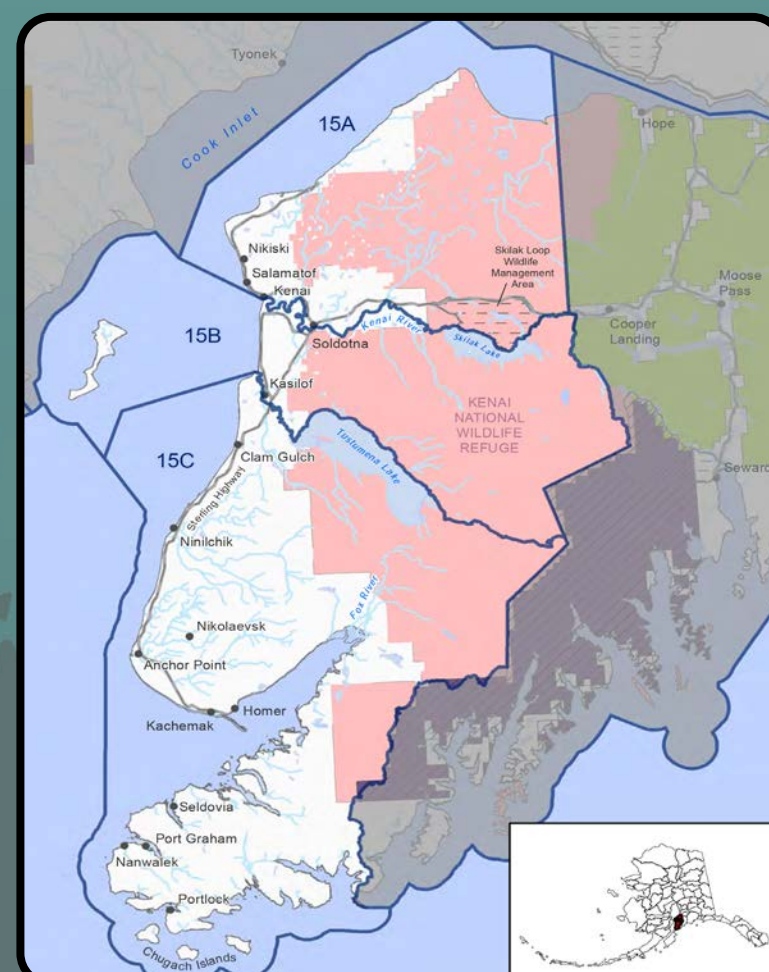
