STATE REGULATIONS

DOGS USED TO HUNT BLACK BEARS ONLY WITH ADF&G PERMIT

PROOF OF SEX AND CLAWS MUST REMAIN NATURALLY ATTACHED TO MEAT

CUBS OR SOWS WITH CUBS

RESIDENTS MUST POSSESS A \$25 LOCKING-TAG TO HUNT BROWN/GRIZZLY BEAR

YOU MUST COMPLETE AN ADF&G APPROVED BEAR BAITING CLINIC

ALL BAIT STATIONS MUST BE REGISTERED AT ADF&G

BROWN & BLACK BEARS KEEP & SEAL

BLACK BEARS KEEP & SEAL

ALL BEARS MUST BE SEALED AT ANY ADF&G OFFICE

BROWN BEARS BAITING

6A, 6B & 6C BAIT HUNTING APRIL 15 TO JUNE 15

COUNT A WOUNDED BROWN BEAR AGAINST A HUNTERS CURRENT YEAR BAG LIMIT REGIONWIDE

IN BLACKSTONE BAY AND HARRIMAN FJORD OF UNIT 6D, BAIT OR BAIT STATIONS **MAY NOT BE USED**

NO BEAR BAIT CAN BE ESTABLISHED WITHIN 1/4 MILE OF TRAIL OR ROAD. NO BAIT SITE CAN BE ESTABLISHED WITHIN 1 MILE OF A DWELLING, CABIN, OR HOME

THE ANIMAL TAKEN WILL BE COUNTED AGAINST THE ADULT'S HARVEST LIMIT

<10 YRS OLD HUNTER AT THE START OF THE HUNT MAY NOT BE ISSUED A FEDERAL SUBSISTENCE PERMIT

A RESPONSIBLE ADULT MUST MAKE SURE ALL LAWS ARE FOLLOWED

BROWN & BLACK BEARS

NO BEAR BAIT CAN BE ESTABLISHED WITHIN 1/4 MILE OF TRAIL OR ROAD. NO BAIT SITE CAN BE ESTABLISHED WITHIN 1 MILE OF A DWELLING, CABIN, OR HOME
