STATE REGULATIONS



COUNT A WOUNDED **BROWN BEAR** AGAINST A HUNTER'S CURRENT YEAR BAG LIMIT REGIONWIDE

ANYONE BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1986 OR IS 18YO OR OLDER MUST HAVE PASSED AN ADF&G HUNTER EDUCATION COURSE TO HUNT BIG GAME IN ALASKA

NO BEAR BAIT CAN BE ESTABLISHED WITHIN 1/4 MILE OF TRAIL OR ROAD. **NO BAIT SITE** CAN BE ESTABLISHED WITHIN 1 MILE OF A DWELLING, CABIN, OR HOME

BAIT MAY NOT BE USED AND BAIT STATIONS **MAY NOT** BE REGISTERED IN UNIT 7 - RESURRECTION CREEK AND TRIBUTARIES AND WITHIN ONE-QUARTER MILE OF THE SHORELINE OF THE KENAI RIVER (INCLUDING KENAI LAKE)

YOU MAY NOT HUNT, TRAP, OR TAKE WILDLIFE WITHIN A QUARTER MILE OF WILDLIFE CROSSING STRUCTURES ALONG THE STERLING HIGHWAY

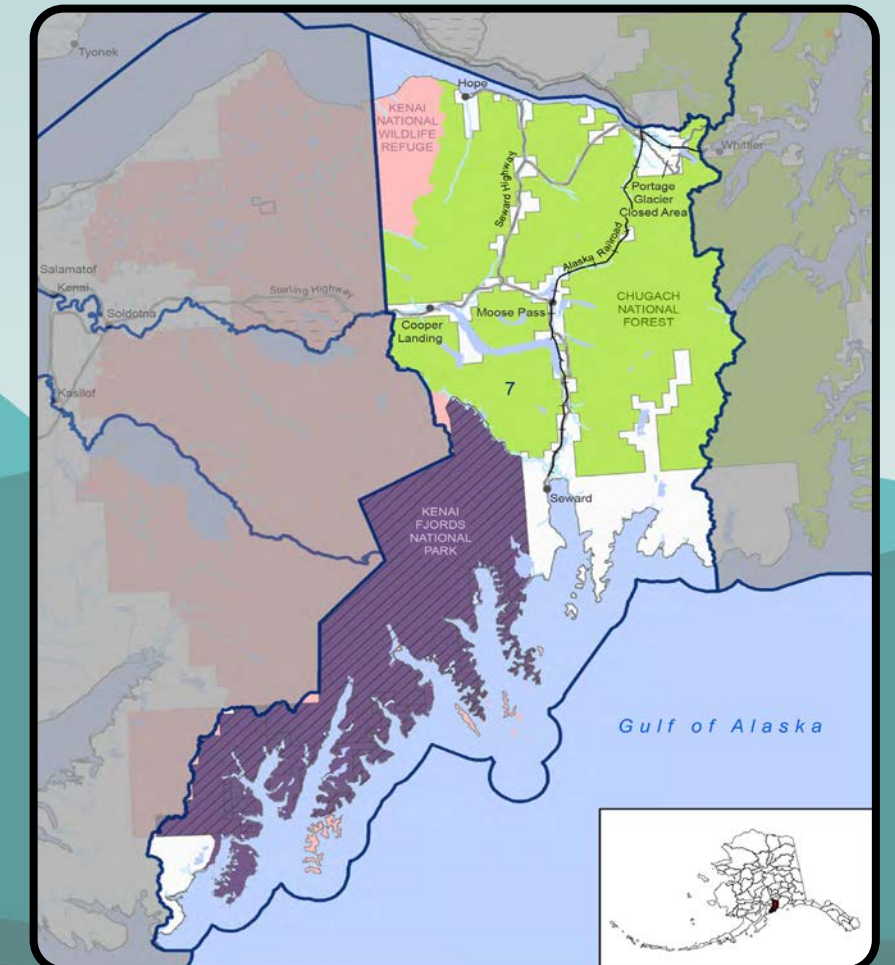

THE ANIMAL TAKEN WILL BE COUNTED AGAINST THE ADULT'S HARVEST LIMIT

<10 YRS OLD HUNTER AT THE START OF THE HUNT MAY NOT BE ISSUED A FEDERAL SUBSISTENCE PERMIT

A RESPONSIBLE ADULT MUST MAKE SURE ALL LAWS ARE FOLLOWED

7	All Rural Residents		JULY 1 to JUNE 30	Federal public lands within Kenai Fjords National Park are closed to all hunting, including the hunting of wildlife for subsistence purposes. Portage Glacier Closed Area, which consists of Portage Creek drainages between the Anchorage/Seward Railroad and Placer Creek in Bear Valley, Portage Lake, the mouth of Byron Creek, Glacier Creek, and Byron Glacier, is closed to hunting. Bait may be used to hunt black bear between April 15 - June 15; except in the drainages of Resurrection Creek and its tributaries.
